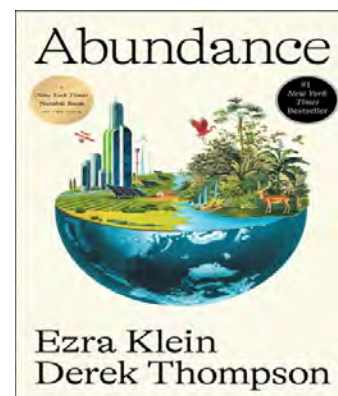
Pro-Democracy Book Club—The Book Club is not meeting in July.
